Nominal Group Process was used to inform the Coalition on priorities for their work over the next year. The question before the committee is "What actions should we undertake this year to move toward full implementation of the IOM Future of Nursing recommendations?"

Generation of Action Statements:

Members were given 10 minutes to write down action statements for consideration, keeping in mind the IOM recommendations.

Sharing of Action Statements:

All generated action statements were shared as substance for priority setting. Items were reviewed for clarification, duplicates combined, and related items consolidated.

Priority ranking:

Each member selected top ten priorities, and assigned a priority rating to each. The consolidated group priority ratings are attached. The rating number shows the relative importance of each item to the group members present and voting.

Process recommendations:

In addition to actions related to the IOM recommendations, the following suggestions related to how the OAC could accomplish its work.

- 1. Form a data and research committee to study and answer questions that arise.
- 2. Assign an expert for each IOM recommendation. The expert would prepare preliminary reports of IOM recommendations in Oregon and draft a plan of action for needed work.
- 3. Create a community of experts on each IOM recommendation.
- 4. Include all of Oregon in OAC's work
