<p>CFA Meeting</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Leslie and Jana attended the Campaign for Action national meeting on Nov. 17-19 in Phoenix, Arizona, representing Oregon. Jake Creviston also attended and was honored as one of 10 Breakthrough Leaders of Nursing. Another OAC SC member, Gladys Campbell, also attended as part of the Washington delegation. The meeting focused on promoting nurses to policy-making boards and increasing leadership opportunities. The conference also addressed generational differences that may affect the workplace in the future, and ways to create a culture of health. The Campaign for Action is beginning a 10K Nurses on Boards drive. The goal is that by 2020 (five years) 10,000 additional nurses will be serving on boards. Leslie and Jana met with Ellen Brzytwa who has served on a number of healthcare boards and currently sits on the board of The Cleveland Clinic. She shared insights about selecting the appropriate board and determining the fit between the nurse and the particular board. CFA is providing resources and support for AC's and volunteer engagement.
