Planned Activities /Outcomes [current]

- Engage in a contractual relationship (through NWONE) with CAP2 Gladys and Christy Cowgill
 met with the CAP2 leaders in Chicago and spent a day learning about their services and data base.
 We began discussion related to a first draft contract and plan to continue our negotiations in
 hopes of reaching an agreement.
- A formal presentation on CAP2 shared by Gladys, Christy and Debra McElroy of the CAP2 group is on the formal agenda for the NWONE fall program
- The theme for the 2014 NWONE fall program is "The Affordable Care Act as Opportunity: Advancing the Contribution of Nursing to the Public's Health" to align with the work of the OAC.
- A conference call with AACN to discuss bringing their CSI program to the NW was held on June 17. The dialogue went well and we plan to continue the discussion related to bringing the CSI program into the NW.
- Educational program on Getting Nurses on Board(s) was completed very positive reviews were received 130 nurses attended
- The Best on Board program is currently enrolling participants from the NW
- 3 nurse trustee mentors have been identified
