Please hold the date and plan to attend this provocative statewide summit as we aim to embark on introducing critical conversation about Oregon’s nursing workforce for the future! In addition, the IOM Future of Nursing report and the Doctor of Nursing Practice degree are changing the nursing education landscape. Academe and practice must partner to consider the knowledge, skills and competencies needed for the future.

OHSU School of Nursing is hosting a state-wide Academic-Practice Summit to begin a formal dialog on these topics. Thought leaders from our clinical partners will meet with OHSU faculty on each of our campuses – Portland, Ashland, Klamath Falls, La Grande and Monmouth. Together we will review major state and national trends, consider the competencies needed for the future of nursing in relation to health care transformation and baccalaureate and higher degree nursing education, and plan for continuing dialog and action.
